Academic Dress

All graduands are requested to collect their academic dress from the University from 9th June 2026.

The applicable fees per set of academic attire are as follows;

Masters' Degree: **MK160,000.00**

Graduates are required to return the academic attire immediately after the graduation ceremony when collecting their certificates. Failure to return the attire will attract a daily penalty equivalent to the graduation processing fee.

Please note that Certificates shall be released only when all applicable fees and any accrued penalties have been paid in full.

Graduating in Absentia

Students who intend to graduate in absentia are encouraged to inform the Registrar as soon as possible. Such students will be required to pay the following fees for graduating in absentia:

Bachelor's Degree/UCE: **MK50,000.00**

Master's Degree: **MK75,000.00**

Rehearsals

Graduation rehearsals will be held on 16th June, 2026 from 9:00 am at MUBAS main campus in Blantyre. All candidates are expected to be punctual. Only those who attend rehearsals shall be permitted to parade for graduation.
