Abstracts should not be more than 250 words. All abstracts should be on standards A4 papers, 1.5 spaced and font must be 12 point and Times New Roman.

The abstract should include the following information:

- 2. The preferred sub-theme
- 3. Corresponding author details
- 4. A list of co-authors, including affiliations
- 5. Paper type (research paper, review, case study, conceptual paper, etc.)
- 6. Purpose
- 7. Methodology/Approach
- 8. Findings
- 9. Recommendations
- 10. Conclusion
- 11. Originality/Value of Contribution
- 12. 5 key words
