Entry Requirements:

- i. Minimum qualification is **MSCE** or equivalent with at least passes in Mathematics and Physical Science/General Science,
- ii. Candidates with at least a Grade 1 or 2 Malawi Trade Test Certificate in a related field are encouraged to apply.

General Information:

- i. Tuition fee includes all required **practical lessons** and **at least half of the fees** have to be deposited when enrolling,
- ii. Candidates are required to pay examination fees to City & Guilds through the centre of the Institute of Continuing Education(ICE).
- iii. All courses are offered both weekdays and weekends and are on a non-residential basis,
- iv. Registration is in progress and classes will run from 19th January, 2026 to 12th June, 2026, exams shall be administered early June, 2026.
- v. All new students should pay a once-off, non-refundable registration fee of **K10, 000.00**, which should be deposited into the following National Bank current account: **MUBAS**, **Account number: 433578**,
- vi. Forms can be collected from MUBAS Main Campus, Mechanical Engineering Fabrication workshop (**T6**) or Motor Vehicle Workshop (**T5**). Alternatively, they can be downloaded from www.mubas.ac.mw.
- vii. Female candidates are encouraged to apply.
