Entry Requirements:

- Minimum qualification is **MSCE** or equivalent with at least passes in Mathematics and Physical Science/General Science,
- Candidates with at least a Grade 1 or 2 Malawi Trade Test Certificate in a related field are encouraged to apply.

General Information:

- Tuition fee includes all required **practical lessons** and **at least half of the fees** have to be deposited when enrolling,
- Candidates are required to pay examination fees to City & Guilds through the centre of the Institute of Continuing Education(ICE).
- All courses are offered both **weekdays** and **weekends** and are on a **non-residential basis**,
- Registration is in progress and classes will run from **19th January, 2026 to 12th June, 2026**, exams shall be administered **early June, 2026**.
- All new students should pay a once-off, non-refundable registration fee of **K10, 000.00**, which should be deposited into the following National Bank current account: **MUBAS, Account number: 433578**,
