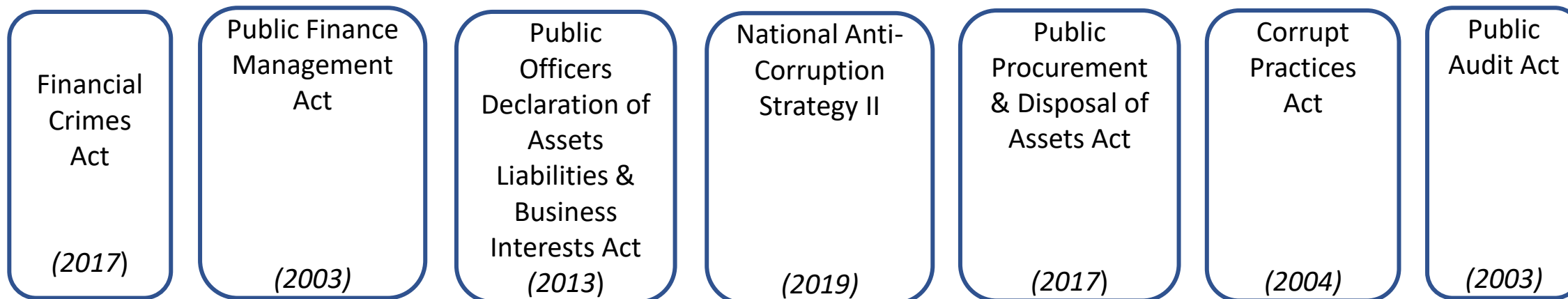

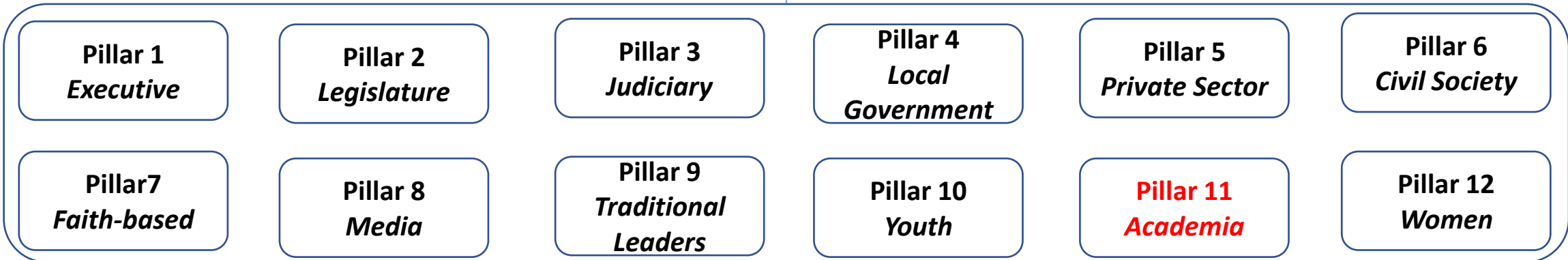

Scope of work for MUBAS IIC

- Develop, implement and review Anti-Corruption Action Plan
- Sensitize staff, students, and key stakeholders on corruption and fraud
- Develop and implement corruption prevention tools
- Conduct work systems reviews & procedures & implement recommendations
- Develop and publicize effective corruption reporting mechanisms
- Monitor procurement processes
- Perform corruption risk assessment
- Promote ethics and integrity
- Develop client service charter and ensure publicity
- Conduct lifestyle audits
- Investigate suspected corruption
- Recommend administrative action to management



Investigation activities & reporting

- Investigation activities

- Enquiries/ fact finding/information collating
- Evidence gathering
- Information analysis
- Surveillance
- Conducting of searches
- Interviewing witnesses & suspects.
- Writing reports

- Reporting

- Approval for investigation through controlling officer
- Recommendations to be made to management
- Complaint can be referred to ACB



Complaints handling

- Complaints:

- to be received through any form including reports or referrals from ACB, Police etc
- can be anonymous or not
- should be of good motive
